

Transition Assessment Chart

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The purpose of a transition assessment is to gather valuable data about a student's strengths, preferences, interests, and needs as they prepare to transition from school to postsecondary life. These data are then used to write measurable annual goals in education and/or training, employment and career, and independent living, as appropriate. Furthermore, transition assessment data helps the IEP team to write annual goals in alignment with broader postsecondary goals and to identify transition services needs of the student.

Academic-Based Transition Assessments

Academic data will assist the IEP team in writing postsecondary goals that are reflective of the student's present levels of performance, both functionally and academically. This data can be gathered from the following areas:

Statewide, standardized assessments (no cost)
